



## The Basic Stamping Tools – Limited Time Offer

When you begin to stamp, these are the essential items that you need. Of course, there are many items that you can add, but this is what I recommend. The bundle you choose, depends on your budget and what you already own.

### Assumptions:

1. You are taking a Stamped Impression online card class.
2. You'll purchase a stamp set used in the class.
3. You'll purchase A2 envelopes (4-3/8" x 5-3/4") from somewhere.
4. You have stuff at home that you can use, such as glue and scissors.

But, when you're ready to add some Stampin' Up! tools, here are the bundles I offer:

What you can use, besides what's on the chart:

1. If you don't have a Stampin' Pierce Mat, you can use a stack of scrap printing paper, 1/4" – 1/2" thick.
2. If you don't have a Paper Trimmer, then you can use scissors (if you can cut straight), or a hobby craft blade plus straight edge.
3. If you don't own the Simply Shammy, then you can use wet paper towels on a flat salad plate.

While it's not necessary, I recommend that you have Bundle 1 before Bundle 2, and Bundle 2 before Bundle 3. But it's really not a hard-and-fast rule.

My bundle prices include shipping & sales tax. However, buying these products in different combinations means that you will pay the usual shipping and sale tax. **This is a limited time offer.**

Of course, there are many upgrades and additional products to the ones shown here. But these groups of tools will get you started. Remember, that you really don't need to buy everything all at one time.
